Please find the response provided below.

Question: "I am a member of the public (living in central Cambridge) who is interested in why Mr Whiteley received such a generous payout from public funds."

Answer: Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority and Mr Whiteley came to an agreement to end his employment by mutual agreement. The sum of £94,500 which included sums relating to contractual notice and compensation for loss of office is part of that agreement.
