Job Purpose

The role will be integral to delivering a new impactful bus franchising model for the region. Focussed on delivering responsive and robust evidence bases, such as an annual review of bus network performance and more regular reporting. The work of the Data Analyst will inform short and long-term policy positioning, strategy and business case development, including future funding requirements from national government related to public transport

Key Responsibilities

- Provide analysis of datasets using MS Excel and other software, to inform research, policies, strategies, evaluations and performance reporting.
- Provide accurate, timely, consistent, and relevant information and analysis for colleagues across the organisations in accordance with planned activity.
- Communicate the findings of analysis in the form of written reports, presentations, blogs, infographics and other communication methods.
- Support internal evaluations using qualitative and quantitative research methods, reporting findings in a way that provides valuable support to policy development and ensuring effective dissemination of findings to key stakeholders in order to shape future strategy and policy.
- Support the production of relevant data reporting where required. This may include reports provided to the Combined Authority Board, Thematic Committees and Corporate Management Team; Reports may require data processing, analysis and visualisation, selecting indicators and supporting target setting.
