Notice is hereby given that the draft Statement of Accounts for the 2023-24 financial year for the Combined Authority will be available on the Authority's website from **1st June 2024 to 12th of July 2024 inclusive**.

The Authority's accounts are subject to external audit by **Debbie Hanson of Ernst & Young LLP, 400 Capability Green, Luton, Bedfordshire LU1 3LU**. Members of the public and local government electors have certain rights in the audit process during this period:

1. Any person may inspect the accounts of the Authority for the year ended 31st March 2024 and certain related documents.
2. A local government elector for the area of the Combined Authority, or their representative, may ask the local auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact the auditor at the address given above to make arrangements to ask any questions.
3. A local government elector for the area of the Combined Authority, or his/her representative, may object to the Combined Authority's accounts asking that the auditor issue a report in the public interest (under section 24 and paragraph 1 of Schedule 7 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014) and/or apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law (under section 28 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014). Written notice of a proposed objection, the facts on which it relies and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to me at the address given below.
