Answer 7: Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority do not have a framework agreement for electricity and gas.

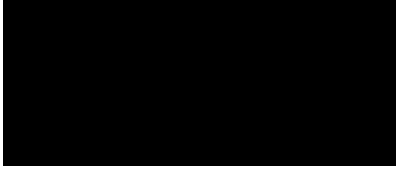
