With reference to your request for information received on 14 July 2021 reference CA129 please find the response provided below.

Question:

I would like to request under the Freedom of Information Act what correspondence, meetings, and events councillors and officials of at Cambridge and Peterborough Combined Authority have had with Huawei, Hikvision, Dahua, Hisense, Alibaba, Tencent and Bytedance (TikTok) in the last six months.

Answer:

The Mayor, Dr Nik Johnson, virtually met with Huawei Technologies on 2 August. There is one email from the Government Affairs Director to confirm the appointment. This is the only correspondence, meeting or event between councillors or officials of Cambridge and Peterborough Combined Authority and Huawei, Hikvision, Dahua, Hisense, Alibaba, Tencent and Bytedance (TikTok) in the last six months.
