*The current budget and MTFP was approved by the CPCA Board in January 2021. Details of funding that it receives is provided under paragraph 4 – see link below.*

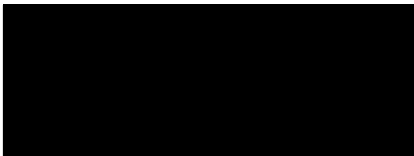
