#### **Response**

The Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority operate as the Local Transport Authority, not the Highways Authority. Your questions within the CON29R form should be directed to the Highways or Planning Authorities within the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough region.

The Combined Authority is predominantly a funding organisation to those authorities who then progress them. There are two exceptions where the Combined Authority has progressed the studies directly, the links to the Combined Authority Board papers of each are below:

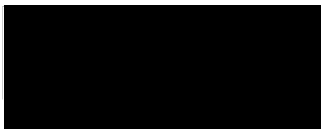
Neither of these studies have route protection on at this stage and are purely at early study stages.
