Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request Reference C153

With reference to your request for information dated 3 February 2022 received on 10 February 2022 reference CA153, please find the response provided below.

Request

You may recall that I wrote to you on 9 Jan 22 with regard to a Freedom of Information request about Bus Lanes in Cambridge. Copy of letter enclosed for ease of reference.

In my letter I explained the history to my request and enclosed copies of my letters to other agencies. The first letter was written on 18 Nov 21. I have enclosed these letters again.

I also stated that I was confused as to which agency should deal with my request. Therefore I asked that you acknowledge receipt of my letter and, if you were not the correct agency, that you advise me the correct office to send the request.

Sadly, to date I have not heard from you, nor any other agency.

The information I ask for is still required and is laid out in my first letter, dated 18 Nov 21 - enclosed.


Response

The Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority do not hold the information you have requested. In Cambridgeshire and Peterborough, bus lane and bus gate enforcement is managed by Cambridgeshire County Council and not the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority.
