Request

I am writing to make a request for data, under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Please could you send me the newest available data (2021-2022 / 2020-2021 / 2019-2020) relating specifically to the city of Peterborough on: • The total amount of textile waste produced in the city each year (kg/tonnes) • The total amount of non-commercial textile waste produced in the city each year (kg/tonnes) • What percentage of total textile waste each year is non-commercial textiles waste? • What percentage of the total amount of textiles waste is incinerated each year? • What percentage of the total amount of textiles waste ends up in a landfill each year? • What is the total amount of CO² produced through textile waste management each year within the city? If this request is too wide or unclear, I would be grateful if you could contact me as I understand that under the Act, you are required to advise and assist requesters. If any of this information is already in the public domain, please can you direct me to it, with page references and URLs if necessary.
