Response

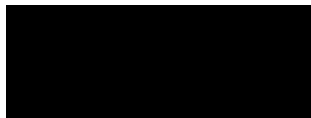
Again, we do not track staff religious preference so cannot confirm if any British Muslims have been employed in our communications team and would not want to assume on outward appearance or names.
