Question a.

How many staff does the combined authority directly employ (excluding contractors or subcontractors), that work directly for the combined authority?

Question b.

How many directly employed staff spend 3 or more days per week (0.6 FTE) on implementing the Climate Action Plan or other climate change projects? Please provide a list of all the roles.

This may include staff who spend 60% of their time on climate change projects and 40% of their time on other work.
