Thank you for your request for information received on 21 February 2023. The response is given below:

Request

- a) How many green skills adult education courses have been provided by the Combined Authority, and;
- b) How many people have been trained on the above green skills/green jobs adult education courses provided by the Combined Authority?

Response

The table below summarises for the devolved **Adult Education Budget** for the 2021/22 full academic year, the number of people trained and the associated funding. Because individual qualification figures would have been disclosive we have provided a figure for the overall category, rounding learners and enrolments to the nearest 10 and funding to the nearest £100. The 'X' notifies where learners/enrolments are less than 10.
