The £466m figure is quoted in the Outline Business Case for the Ely Area Capacity Enhancement Programme dated March 2022. This document was prepared by Network Rail in partnership with Department for Transport and Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority NewAnglia Local Enterprise Partnership for Norfolk and Suffolk.
