Request

What specifically was the Mayoral Precept spent on e.g. financial breakdown, for 2022-23 and budget forecast spending from funds raised by the Mayoral Precept relating to tax year 2023-24. Did the Mayor ever use public transport to attend activities?

Response

There was no Mayoral Precept for the year 2022-23.

For 2023-24 the forecast income from the mayoral precept is \pounds 3.624m, and the entire amount is being used to increase the budget for supported bus services from \pounds 3.4m in 2022-23 to \pounds 7.0m in 2023-24.

The Mayor's Precept was discussed at the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority Board on 25 January 2023 – item 2.1 Attached is a link to the CA Board meeting <u>CMIS > Meetings</u>

The Mayor used public transport to attended the following activities in 2022-2023:
