## Re: Freedom of Information request ref CA241

Thank you for your request for information received on 12 July 2023. The response is given below:

#### Question 1

In 2023, did the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority receive statutory notification from Stagecoach East as to their intention to withdraw the number 36 bus service between Thorney and Eye? Please provide a copy of the document received and confirm the date of receipt from the Combined Authority.

### Response

Stagecoach gave the Combined Authority 70 days' notice of their intention to withdraw bus service 36, as per guidance issued by the Department for Transport. Attached is an email from Paul Morfitt dated 18 May 2023, showing the date that the email was sent, and the date it was received. Information which is not regarding Service 36 has been redacted.

### Question 2

With regard to the change in service to the number 36 bus, did the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority respond to Stagecoach's statutory notice within the 28 days given? If so, please provide a copy of your response.

### Response

A completed proforma was issued to Stagecoach on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2023, within the initial 28-day period, as per the guidance issued by the Department for Transport. The form that was sent to Stagecoach is attached.


