Thank you for your request for information received on 13 October 2023. The response is given below:

***Request***

Please can you provide the following information for the financial year 2022-2023.

**Response**

Cambridgeshire & Peterborough Combined Authority combined the operation of the Peterborough Bus Pass Scheme into one system with Cambridgeshire County's on 1 February 2023. Previously there were two separate systems.

**Question 1: How many concessionary bus passes were issued?**

Answer: 37,030 bus passes were issued in total (29,958 in Cambridgeshire; 7,072 in Peterborough)

**Question 2: How many disabled bus passes were issued?**

Answer: We do not hold this information.

**Question 3 How much was spent on all concessionary bus pass travel?**

Answer: £7,506,472 was spent on all concessionary travel (including non-statutory). £5,070,920 in Cambridgeshire and £2,435,552 in Peterborough.

**Question 4: How much was spent on disabled bus pass travel?**

Answer: We do not hold this information.

**Question 5: How many bus trips were made by concessionary bus pass holders?**

Answer: There were 4,203,776 bus pass journeys in total (2,666,882 in Cambridgeshire and 1,536,894 in Peterborough).

**Question 6: How many bus trips were made by disabled bus pass holders?**

Answer: We do not hold this information

**Question 7: How many bus trips were made by disabled bus pass holders before 9:30am?**

Answer: We do not hold this information

**Question 8: How many bus trips were made by disabled bus pass holders after 11pm?**

Answer: We do not hold this information.

**Question 9: Do you offer a young person's bus pass? And if you do, what are the benefits of the young person's bus pass?**

Answer: We do not offer a young person's bus pass.

**Question 10: Does the disabled bus pass include free travel for a travelling companion?**

Answer: We do not offer a travelling companion bus pass.

**Question 11: How much additional cost would there be if you lifted the time restrictions and provided free bus travel at all times for all disabled bus pass holders per financial year?**

Answer: We do not hold this information.

For information, the DfT is considering removing time restrictions for all pass holders.



**Question 12: Please can you explain how you calculated this figure.**

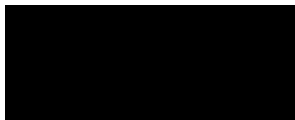
Answer: See above.
