Thank you for Twitter request which was posted on 30 August 2018 where you requested information about Mr Whiteley. Your question is "*regarding your outgoing Chief Executive Martin Whitely, what payments have been made to him as part of him leaving his position? Are there any parachute, redundancy or other payments involved in this*"?

We confirm that we hold this information. Mr Whitley's employment ended with his resignation by mutual agreement on 30 September 2018 with a Settlement Agreement. Whilst the Authority maintains an exemption under Section 40 (Personal Information) in relation to the agreement itself, we can confirm that Mr Whiteley was paid the sum of £94,500 which included contractual notice and compensation for loss of office. The payment was subject to deductions for PAYE and NI. In answer to your specific requests, there were no so-called parachute payments, and neither was this a redundancy situation.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter.
