Re: Freedom of Information request - ref CA274 - Internal Review

Thank you for your request for an internal review received on 26 December 2023. The response is given below:

Request

Please could I request a copy of any reports, studies, presentations, documents, meeting minutes and details of work items with consultants published in 2023 relating to existing and proposed DRT services run by, or run in conjunction with, the CPCA.

I would expect this information to cover:

1. The existing Ting service and in particular the recommendation to retain and refocus the service, the underlying information used to make this recommendation, and the nature of that refocusing stated as "a focus on the more rural communities which are not serviced by other routes."

2. The proposed Fenland, East Cambridgeshire and South Cambridgeshire DRT services.

3. The CPCA's recent stated list of potential benefits for DRT: Flexibility and Convenience; Improved Accessibility; Cost-Efficiency; Reduced Congestion and Emissions; Tailored Services for Specific Groups; Technology Integration; Adaptability to Changing Urban Dynamics; Reduced Need for Personal Vehicle Ownership.

4. A comparison with alternatives such as timetabled services, and semi-flexible services.

Please could you also provide the plan of work to develop the pilots including timescales and reports which are expected to be produced, and details any work which will be done by consultants.

No reports, studies, presentations, documents with consultants relating to existing and proposed DRT services run by, or run in conjunction with, the CPCA have been published in 2023.

Internal Review

Request

I looked at the DRT discussion in September 2023 and included the following mentioning reviews, research and assessments which had been carried out.

"In parallel to the Bus Network Review, a review of Demand Response Transport (DRT), as a way to complement scheduled bus services, has been undertaken. The review of DRT highlights that the DRT approach can be suitable for providing connections to some communities and that there is scope to trial a further four pilots in the CPCA area. The suggested pilot areas are: Wittering area, Wisbech area, East Cambridgeshire and Longstanton. Each of the four trial areas have been estimated to cost £300k per trial per year, based on using two vehicles. The option to introduce a new subsidised service, whether that be scheduled or demand responsive should be taken as part of the bus network review."

and

"To support decision on the pilot DRT services, each will be assessed against the metrics used for the bus network review. This assessment will be undertaken ahead of the final recommendations on the bus review and presented to members of the Committee and CPCA Board in November for consideration."

and

"CPCA has undertaken research to examine the Future Role of DRT in Cambridgeshire and Peterborough. The research was commissioned to examine the application of Demand Responsive Transport across the UK and provide an understanding of applicability to the

Combined Authority area within the short (less than two years), medium (two to five years) and long term (10 to 20 years)."

and

" CPCA officers have undertaken an initial review of the Ting service which is operating in Huntingdonshire."

This seems completely at odds with your statement that "No reports, studies, presentations, documents with consultants relating to existing and proposed DRT services run by, or run in conjunction with, the CPCA have been published in 2023." You have also made no mention of my request for information about the pilots, or information about the stated potential benefits of DRT.

Please can you explain this discrepancy and provide any missing information not only in relation to the reviews, research and assessments mentioned in the four paragraphs from the September meeting quoted above, but also any others relating to my original request.

Response

The request asked for published documents. At the time of responding to the request, there were no published documents.
