Thank you for your request for information received on 12/12/2023. The response is given below:

Request

On the 1/12/23 and the 02/12/12 Whittlesey Science and Technology Park Developments Ltd (registration 13860506) presented plans for a science park at the former Victory and Saxon Pit works in Whittlesey Town at a public forum.


The project is known as either the Peterborough or Whittlesey Science and Technology Park. It will be at the former brick pit known as Victory Pit.

I would like to know if any public money has been provided, granted or loaned by the combined authority to any private company involved with this project. Also, if there has been such financial activity, I would like to know the amount and purpose along with any caveats and timescales relating to any such public money.

I would also like to be informed if there are any plans to provide such funding in the future.

Response

To date no public money has been provided, granted or loaned by the combined authority to any private company involved with this particular project to develop a science and technology park at the former Victory and Saxon Pit works near Whittlesey.
