Request

In the DfT document "National Bus Strategy: 2024 Bus Service Improvement Plans Guidance to local authorities and bus operators (January 2024)", available at <https://assets.publishing.service.gov.uk/media/65a6becf96a5ec000d731aa9/bus-service-improvement-plans-guidance-to-local-authorities-and-bus-operators-2024.pdf>

It states on Page 12:

"Requirements

39. All LTAs produced a BSIP in 2021 and published it on their website in an appropriate and easy-to-find location. All LTAs seeking to be in receipt of DfT BSIP funding should publish an updated and refreshed BSIP, superseding the 2021 document, by 12 June 2024, also submitting a copy to DfT at <DfT email address>"

As a response to this Freedom of Information request, please advise where the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority updated and refreshed BSIP has been published, and additionally advise if a copy was submitted to DfT in time for the 12th of June 2024 date or not.

Response

Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority (CPCA) has produced an updated and refreshed BSIP, in line with DfT requirements for the specified deadline (12th June).

At the March 2024 CPCA Board meeting, it was agreed that a draft BSIP would be submitted by the Executive Director acting with the chair of the Transport and

Infrastructure Committee by the DFT deadline. This was a provisional document subject to approval and review by the committee processes.

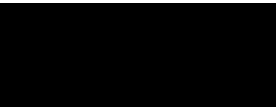
The BSIP has not been published as yet as it is subject to sign off via the Transport and Infrastructure Committee on 22 July and CPCA board on 24 July 2024.
