Thank you for your request for information which was received on **11 July 2024**

***Request***

Please could you provide a budget breakdown of all spend on people with learning disabilities that the Council has incurred for the financial year 2022/23 please.

I would like to know:

- How much you spend on residential care (on on how many placements)
- How much you spend on domiciliary care (an on how many placements)
- How much is pent on day opportunities (and across how many locations/providers)
- How much is spent on employment support (and on how many providers)
- the contract value for each of the requests above.

Please could you also confirm if these contracts are all or in part let through either a framework agreement or direct purchasing system (DPS), and if so, how often the Council offers new providers the opportunity to join this framework or DPS.

**Response**

Unfortunately, we do not hold the requested information. In Cambridgeshire and Peterborough, it is Cambridgeshire County Council and Peterborough City Council that are responsible for Children's Services and Adult Social Care and would therefore hold any relevant information, rather than us.
