Thank you for your request for information received on 5th November 2024. The response is given below:

Request:

Can you kindly provide the following

Total amount of money raised by Peterborough city council tax payers to fund bus services per year, since the bus precept costs have been introduced

Total amount spent on bus services that operate only within the Peterborough city council area.

For clarity, bus services that operate outside Peterborough city council boundary are excluded.

Response:

The below table outlines the amount that PCC residents have contributed to the precept. As we're part-way through 24/25, PCC won't yet have paid the full amount of the annual council tax bill but the figure provided covers the whole financial year.

	2023/24	2024/25 (forecast)
Precept	£717,283	£2,235,733

The total budget for spend on bus services for the PCC area for 24/25 is £1,497,640. In addition to this budget are the below services for Peterborough, some of which are still in the delivery stage and as such do not yet have a final contract price.

- A new Peterborough Orbital bus service
- Extension of the route 4 to Thorney and Eye
- Improvements to route 5 with additional evening journeys
- New service (route 27) between Peterborough and Stamford via Wittering
