Thank you for your Freedom of Information request dated 3 April 2025. The response is given below.

Response

After careful consideration of your request, we wish to inform you that we are unable to comply with it under Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This section applies when the cost of complying with the request exceeds the "appropriate limit," as defined by the FOI Act and associated regulations. The appropriate limit is currently set at £450 for public authorities (18 hours). This includes time spent locating, retrieving, and extracting the requested information.

I have attached a link to the relevant section on the ICO website. This provides further details about Section 12. Requests where the cost of compliance exceeds the appropriate limit (section 12) | ICO

Based on our assessment, fulfilling your request would exceed this limit, as it involves searching through an extensive volume of records:

- 3 academic years
- 5 different funding streams
- records for each provider

Breakdown of Work Required:

To obtain the requested information, the following steps would be necessary:

- Liaising with the team for each funding stream
- Liaising with finance for each of the providers to gather funding information
- Locating, retrieving, and extracting the relevant information across teams (the information would require a manual file search as information is not stored in a system)
- Compiling all gathered data

Estimated time needed for each part of your request:

- 1. Lead Provider Details 4 hours
- 2. Funding Breakdown Per Organisation 7 hours
- 3. Performance & Delivery Data 7 hours
- 4. Additional Notes Clarifications 5 hours

To carry out the work required would take an estimated 23 hours. The total time required would therefore exceed the reasonable limit of 18 hours. As a result, your request has been refused under Section 12 of the Act.

We would be happy to assist you in refining your request to bring it within the cost limit. For example, you could narrow the scope of the request by specifying particular documents or prioritise one funding stream (Skills Bootcamp). Please let us know how you would like to proceed.
