Request

Thank you for confirming receipt of FOI request CA413. My apologies in advance, but I would like to amend the request to also include a request for information for points 1 and 2 for Peterborough (in addition to Cambridge). I had contacted Peterborough city council separately but they have today confirmed they do not have the exact information requested.

Response

The e-bike share scheme in Peterborough started on 21 January 2021, paused on 25 October 2021 then restarted on 9th March 2022, before ending fully on 22 December 2022.
