1. Date of Incident
2. Bus Route
3. Local Name of Operator
4. Operator Group Name (if applicable)
5. Injury Description (Fatality, Serious/Minor Injury0 – Taken to Hospital, MinorTreated at Scene)
6. Incident Event Type (Collision, Fall, Assault, other)
7. Victim Category (Passenger, Pedestrian, Cyclists, 3rd Party Vehicle, Bus Driver, other)

***Response***

Contractors are expected to notify the Combined Authority within twenty-four hours of any incident involving loss of life, injury to any party or serious damage to property or vehicles during the performance of a contract and will provide the Combined Authority with a full written report of any such incident within fourteen days. There were no incidents on contracted services reported to the Combined Authority for the period requested. Bus operators are under no obligation to notify us of incidents on commercial bus services.
