Thank you for your request for information received on 11 September 2025. The response is given below:

**Request**

I would like to request the following information regarding the council's use of systems and approaches for managing traffic data:

**General Traffic Data Management**

What systems or tools does the council currently use to collect and manage traffic and transport data, and which internal teams are responsible for their operation?

What are the main purposes these systems serve (e.g. monitoring, reporting, planning support), and what types of transport data are routinely collected?

When were these systems first implemented, and how are they maintained or supported (e.g. in-house, supplier support, framework contracts)?

From which funding sources or budgets are traffic data systems typically supported?

**Future Development and Strategic Direction** Does the council have any plans to adapt or develop its approach to traffic or transport data management in the next few years?

Are there anticipated opportunities for suppliers or researchers to engage with the council on transport data systems, either through tenders, frameworks, or pilot projects?

Has the council been involved in any recent innovation or research activity related to traffic/transport data or intelligent transport systems?

Does the council monitor outcomes linked to traffic data (e.g. congestion, journey reliability, road safety, active travel), and what types of performance measures are most relevant?

## Response
