Answer:

The Combined Authority have not paid or secured any monies in relation to The Mill, Spencer Drove, Soham project. This includes all grants, loans, contributions derived from the Public Purse.

According to the Mill project website – link below for ease <https://www.viva-group.org.uk/viva-mill-project.html> the project has received support from various funders, including Power to Change, Arts Council England, Architectural Heritage Fund, The Amey Community Fund and many more local and national charities and donors. It also states that Viva was awarded £608,200 from the National Heritage Lottery fund, which was matched by East Cambridgeshire District Council.
