Decision taken

Please provide an overview of the decision taken.

The Chief Executive agreed to guarantee additional funding for the Independent Economic Commission.

On 28 June 2017 the Combined Authority agreed to support a percentage of the cost of the Independent Commission amounting to £145K for the current financial year. The total costs of the project were to be split amongst the Combined Authority and Cambridge Ahead.

Cambridge Ahead, the company which is providing both administrative and financial support to the work of the Economic Commission has contacted the Combined Authority to request some assurance regarding the costs of the work. The LEP are currently unable to fund this project as they cannot access Government funding. The Combined Authority is asked to agree to underwrite these costs.

The Combined Authority has agreed to guarantee the funding on the basis that an application will be made to the LEP in accordance with its Assurance Framework requirements for a percentage of the costs once its funding position has been restored.



	Note on procurement (added 24 October): Although the amount of this funding exceeds the current EU procurement threshold level, the Combined Authority is requested to act urgently to provide this guarantee. Guarantees do not fall within the remit of the procurement rules, however should the guarantee be called upon, this might the issue of whether EU procurement rules are subsequently engaged. This project however is one where the services of Cambridge Ahead comprise only a limited proportion of the costs of the funding provided. The funding is expected to be used to commission various studies and reviews which will make up the work of the Commission. A clause will therefore be included as part of the guarantee that an open and transparent procurement process will be carried out commensurate to the level of spend on
	each item which comprises the total funding. State aid does not apply as the services to be commissioned from the funding will be procured according to relevant competition.
