Background Information	<p><i>Currently the dedicated role focussed on the EU funding streams has come to an end of contract. This support role was being contracted through EELGA Talent Bank until 31 March 2020 but Officers have gone out and run a procurement process to appoint a provider to deliver the EU funding support role for the CPCA until 31 March 2021.</i></p> <p><i>The ESIF Support role will be reporting to the Strategic Funds Manager.</i></p>
