Background Information	<p>The Combined Authorities (Overview and Scrutiny Committees, Access to Information and Audit Committees) Order 2017 provides that:</p> <p>9.— Scrutiny officer</p> <p>(1) A combined authority must designate one of its officers as the scrutiny officer of the overview and scrutiny committee to discharge the functions in paragraph (2).</p> <p>(2) Those functions are—</p> <p>(a) to promote the role of the overview and scrutiny committee;</p> <p>(b) to provide support and guidance to the overview and scrutiny committee and its members;</p> <p>(c) to provide support and guidance to members of the combined authority and to the mayor in relation to the functions of the overview and scrutiny committee.</p> <p>(3) A combined authority may not designate as the scrutiny officer any officer of a constituent council of the combined authority.</p> <p>The officer designated as the scrutiny officer is due to go on maternity leave and arrangements must be made for appropriate cover during the period of maternity leave.</p> <p>Despite attempts, including two advertisements amongst constituent authorities and externally to recruit a suitable replacement on an interim contract of employment, the Authority had no candidates with the ability to fulfil this role. In addition, enquiries were made of LGSS who provide Democratic Services to the Authority, but whilst they are able to provide committee support, they were not able to provide an officer.</p> <p>As will be seen above, it is not possible to designate as the scrutiny officer an officer of a constituent authority. Therefore, the only option available was to seek an interim replacement via an agency.</p> <p>This will be for an initial period of 9 months and is dependent on the incumbent returning to work.</p>
