Background Information	
	Context In May the Combined Authority Board approved the Mayoral Interim Transport Strategy Statement. The purpose of the statement is to guide the development of the new LTP and to provide clear direction to transport projects that are either underway or soon to be developed. The MITSS included 16 priority transport projects ranging in scale for transport studies through to the Cambridge Autonomous Metro System.
	In July, the Combined Authority Board received a report that included a schedule of opportunities to accelerate the delivery of each of it's priority projects. The ability of the Combined Authority take the opportunities to



	accelerate delivery will be strongly linked to our ability to grow a client team of sufficient capability and capacity, quickly. As a result, the CA Board agreed to ask officers to assess the potential delivery models to ensure the opportunities to accelerate delivery can be taken and report back to the Board in September. This approach was agreed with the former CEO (M Whitely) and Monitoring Officer – now interim CEO (K Sawyer). The selection of ARUP The ARUP team has been selected as experts from governance, funding and financing, transport, political negotiating, devolution policy and delivery. They also have extensive knowledge and experience of working in the region and with key partners. The team will include Project Director Joanna Rowelle, Richard De Cani, Isabel Dedring, Alison Murray, Darren Briggs, Chloe Salisbury and Jack Stevens. Value for Money Test Due to the requirement to report back to the Board in September the decision was taken to approach a single supplier to undertake the work through a negotiated fee.

	Seek quotations . This was rejected due to the timescale within which the work needs to be undertaken and the particular expertise required.
