Background Information	Dufaylite Developments Ltd is an owner managed business based in the market town of St. Neots in Cambridgeshire. Their growth is being achieved by providing innovative recycled paper honeycomb board solutions to the industrial packaging sector, display sector and the construction sector that replace established plastic-based products. This application has been independently appraised and been recommended for approval of £70,000 towards a £186,000 project that will create 7 new jobs. A future report to Board requesting delegated authority for Directors to sign off small grants is being sought. This is an interim measure.
